

THE REPLACEMENT PROCESS:

- * A request to the city for evaluation of property begins the process.
- * The City will do an evaluation on your system to determine if it is suitable for the program.
- * If your system qualifies for the program, City staff may do a camera inspection of the service to determine which option is best suited.
- * A discussion is held with the property owner and options are presented.
- * An application must be completed and submitted to the Public Works Department authorizing work to proceed.
- * Work will be completed between May 20th and Sept 15th based on contractor availability and property owner scheduling. Projects average 8 hours in length. The sewer will be out of service for 3-5 hours of this time.

COSTS FOR PROJECT:

OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY

- * All required work within the house.
- * Any concrete walk or driveway removal and replacement on property.
- * All landscaping restoration costs.

CITY'S RESPONSIBILITY

- * Obtaining and supervising the contractor.
- * Excavation at the main, tie in, and pipe costs.
- * Pavement, walk and curb restoration.

SHARED COSTS

- * Cost of the excavation, backfill materials and installation is split between the property owner and the City.
- * The percentage of the cost is determined by the distance from the house to the property line divided by total length from house to main.

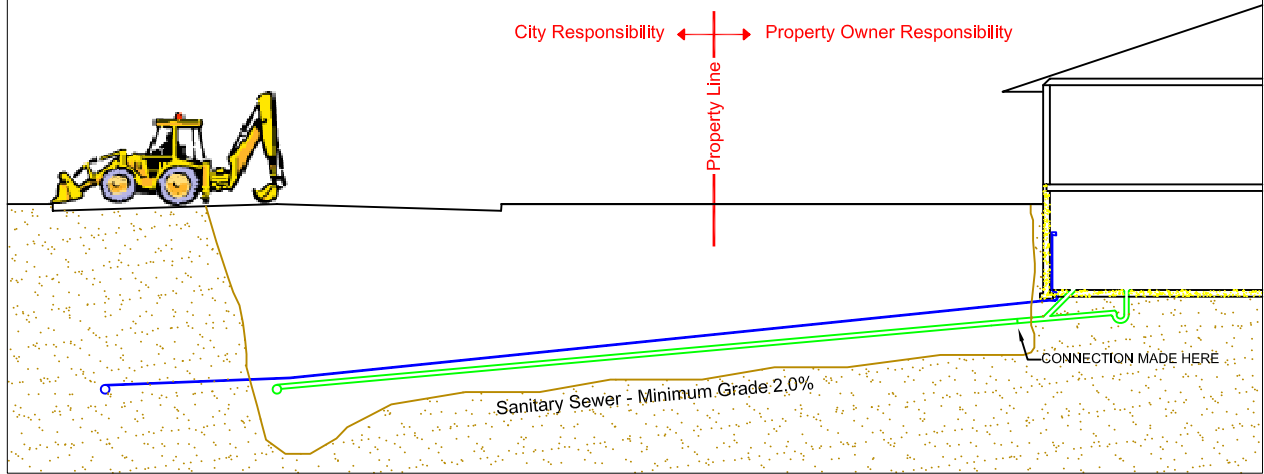

RESIDENTIAL SEWER LATERAL REPLACEMENT PROGRAM



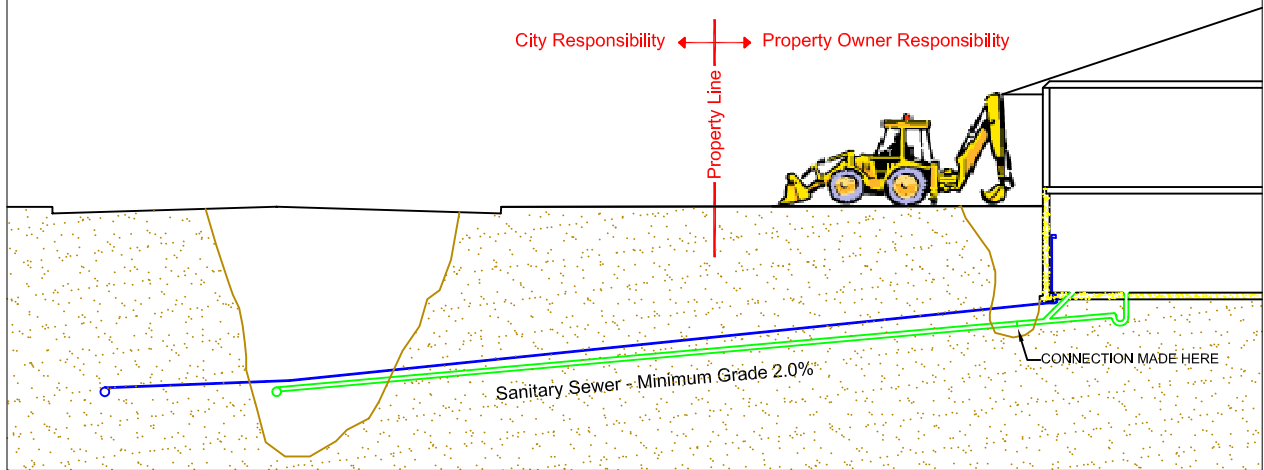
OPTION A
