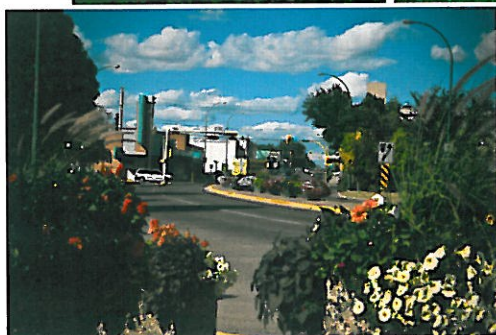

**Anticipated Duties & Responsibilities**

Successful applicants are required to work outdoors with crews in a safe and efficient manner and will be expected to operate both riding and hand operated parks maintenance equipment under guidance & supervision from the Foreman or other permanent employees.

**Duties and Responsibilities could include:**

- Weeding, watering, mulching
- Tree planting
- Mower operation
- String trimmer operation
- Assists with landscape maintenance and construction
- Assists with sport field maintenance – ball diamonds and soccer pitches
- Assists the tree pruning crew
- Operates specialized grounds maintenance and landscape equipment.
- Greenhouse work and flower bed planting and maintenance
- Cemetery maintenance
- Safety Training such as CPR/First Aid, WHMIS, etc.
- Must adhere to all aspects of OH & S as instructed by Supervisor

**Anticipated Duties and Responsibilities**

Successful applicants are required to work with public works crews in a safe and efficient manner. They will be under the guidance of a Foreman/Sub Foreman and/or the supervision of other permanent employees.

**Duties and Responsibilities could include:**

- Must have a valid driver's licence.
- Work could include litter pick up, including back lane cleanup and recycling.
- Must be in excellent physical health as some heavy lifting and raking may be involved.
- May be called upon to work with a cement crew helping senior employees form and pour cement.
- May have to do some yard cleanup and grass cutting.
- May work with senior employees on a patching, pothole or crack filling crew.
- General labourer duties may include setting up snow fence in the fall.
- Possible general painting duties, including helping with the painting program on city streets.
- Setting up the parade route for the fair.
- Must adhere to all aspects of OH & S as instructed by supervisor.
