The pickleball board of directors have surveyed some of the people that fit into this category and the feedback from the participants has led the board to look for a solution to help them have a good experience playing pickleball. The board feels that having them play at a different facility that would be designated for their specific level of play would help create a environment that would grow the number of players and then once established the pickleball club could have the ability to incorporate their level of play into a specific timeline at the fieldhouse. 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


