Project #1 Parks and Rec – City of NB

Remaining Funds Discussion:

The committee discussed the remaining balance of the Sask Lotteries Community Grant funds following the approval of the grant applications.

Members expressed a preference that the remaining funds be used primarily for the purchase of recreation equipment that provides long-term benefit to the community, rather than operational expenses.

Potential items discussed included:

- Recreation equipment for the Field House
- Life jackets for the Aquatic Centre
- Ball hockey nets and outdoor recreation equipment
- A mobile pickleball net
- Possible upgrades to exercise equipment

Director of Parks and Recreation Cheryl DeNeire will review recreation facility needs and determine eligible purchases in accordance with Sask Lotteries Community Grant guidelines. Any remaining funds must be allocated before the end of the grant cycle.

New Business

- Review of school grant policy (\$700 per school, with additional \$700 for community projects).
- Clarification that school applications must come through school administration rather than parent groups.
- Discussion regarding the \$2,000 grant request threshold and potential adjustment.
- Confirmation that the committee meeting schedule of Tuesdays at 5:30 PM continues to work for members.

Youth Representative Update:

- Jana Sharaway shared feedback from students regarding the Field House, noting interest in additional weight equipment and greater variety of exercise equipment. The committee acknowledged the feedback and noted it may be considered when reviewing remaining grant funds.
- Shared feedback and suggestions related to recreation facilities, including ideas for improving visitor pass procedures.
