 - Proposal to use remaining funds of \$600 for new swimming pool equipment like life jackets, rescue tubes, etc.
 - Motion to approve full funding of \$34,434 and allocate the remaining \$600 for pool equipment.

 - Outdoor skating rinks have poor conditions due to thawing and freezing. They may close sooner than expected.
 - Discussions on improvements and potential warming huts for future seasons.

- **Upcoming Events:**

- SHA & BATC Youth Prevention Workshop (April 2025) – Expected 1,000+ attendees at Access Communications Center.
- North Stars Playoffs are beginning
- Canada Day 2025 Planning – Call for new event ideas and committee involvement.

- **Parks & Recreation Projects:**

- Access Arena Replacement Study – Consultant report to be presented on March 31 City Council Meeting.
- New Spray Park at Connaught School – Awaiting agreement finalization with Living Sky School Division.
- Blue Jays Ball Diamond Upgrades – Installation of two aluminum bleachers this summer.
- Skate Park Graffiti Mural Project – Local artists and students will graffiti the skate park to hopefully reduce the amount of graffiti removal required there.

- **Other Community Initiatives:**

- Discussion on potential new recreational programs, including:
 - Youth video game tournaments
 - Roller disco/skating events
 - Duck feeding area
 - Use of Old Tires for Recreational Purposes
