#1 BE IT RESOLVED that the community grant request submitted by Parks and Recreation Department be approved in the amount of \$2,000 to assist with the Shinny Program

#2 BE IT RESOLVED that the community grant request submitted by École Pére Mercure be approved in the amount of \$700 to assist with the Ski Program.

- #3 BE IT RESOLVED that the community grant request submitted by Parks and Recreation Department (InnovationPlex) be approved in the amount of \$35,055.86 to assist with the Fitness and Pool Equipment.
 - Funding request to replace aging strength & cardio equipment on the third floor of the Field House.
 - New equipment will include 3 strength machines, 2 cardio machines, and 1 treadmill.
 - Discussion on maintenance issues with old equipment and impact on user experience.
 - Proposal to use remaining funds of \$600 for new swimming pool equipment like life jackets, rescue tubes, etc.
 - Motion to approve full funding of \$34,434 and allocate the remaining \$600 for pool equipment.
