August 20, 2024



- Storm main installation
- Fire hydrant and manhole replacements
 Underground work should be finished later today by Unicon

Work still underway

- Concrete work expected to start this week
 Paving anticipated to be 2-3 weeks away
- Slight change to plans for paving roads to be paved twice to ensure overlay completely fills potholes/valleys impacting roads

August 20, 2024 continued



- Installation of storm sewer underway this week, should be completed by end of week
- Concrete work set to begin after storm sewer is installed
 Paving to take place in 3-4 weeks

Work 101st Street

- Milling is complete
- Concrete work taking place this week
 Paving to take place one week after concrete is finished



August 20, 2024 continued




Work on 15th Avenue

- Milling work is completed
 Underground work to begin around the end of August/first of September this work may be delayed to start after Labour Day
- Concrete work will begin immediately after the underground work is finished
 Paving will take place a week after the concrete work is complete

Work in Parsons Industrial Park area

- Public meeting held last week at the Library to update area stakeholders on UPAR work
 Road repairs for Thatcher Ave expected to start in September
 Drainage improvements have an anticipated start date of late September

August 20, 2024 continued



Work in Parsons Industrial Park area

 Marquis Ave and Holstein Street work to be completed in September - includes pulverization of the road, with drainage improvements set for late September

Work on alleys/lanes between 102nd/103rd Streets & 11th/13th Avenues

Milling and paving expected to start in September

Work on Territorial Drive, between Highway 16 & Airport Road

Resurfacing expected to start after Labour Day weekend

Info for residents in impacted UPAR zones

Garbage & Recycling

• If your street is under construction & the garbage collector can't reach your bins on the curb, put your bins out and our contractor will move the bins to a place they can be accessed by the garbage truck and then they'll move them back to your property. Labels will be placed on the bins to make sure they're returned to the right address.

Parking Enforcement

- If you are unable to access the street in front of your property for parking, parking enforcement in the areas will not occur on the designated "no parking" days.
- If anyone has been issued a ticket in the construction area and feels it may have been in error, mistakes do happen - please call the CSO office to verify at 306-445-1775.
