Proposed activity/program/event: The Battleford Kinsmen Swim Club (Orcas) is a small non-profit growing swimming program serving the Battlefords and surrounding areas. Our club provides the opportunity for all youth to enjoy a safe, challenging and skilled competitive swimming program in an inclusive and safe environment. Our objectives are to promote amateur competitive swimming to teach interested swimmers the necessary skills to become competitive swimmers, to provide the opportunity for swimmers to develop their maximum potential and to foster and preserve the highest ideas of good sportsmanship, discipline, pride, and respect for oneself and others. The club runs during the months of Sept-June out of the Co-Op Aquatic Centre - offering options to swim 1x, 2x or 4x a week for our participants.

Project description (include objectives of program, and benefits to participants): Project description: The financial assistance requested will help all of our current swimmers for the 2023-24 season and in the future. We currently have 54 youth from the Battlefords and surrounding areas that this will directly benefit. With the financial assistance from this grant we will put it towards the cost of lane rental, part-time coaching fees, in-province Swim meet coaching costs, and updating equipment for our swimmers use. Expected outcome: With the financial assistance requested our club will be able to rent the appropriate number of lanes needed to continue to provide a quality swim program. We also currently have close to 25 swimmers who represent the Battleford Kinsmen Swim Club at a competitive level all around Saskatchewan. As our program grows so does this number and we are proud to represent the Battlefords at the competitive meets and hope to grow this number and provide all our swimmers with the opportunity to experience competitive swim meets. As our numbers grow we must send more than one coach to all meets to ensure safety and support for all swimmers. This year our club is also planning to host two "fun meets" for our younger swimmers to experience what a swim meet is like. Other clubs such as Meadow Lake and Prince Albert and possibly Lloydminster join - making this a fun community event that also brings people to the Battlefords. Our expected outcome from this grant is to help keep our costs down for our youth participants and families - making swimming accessible and affordable for all. This support will also help us grow our program in the Battlefords - allowing us to expand our services to more youth in our community and surrounding areas.


