North Shore Trail – Accessible from Poundmaker Trail this 5.5 km loop runs along the North Shore of the North Saskatchewan River. The trail is in a wooded area and is enjoyed by all levels of hikers and cyclists.

David Laird Municipal Campground

This campground is 2km east of the Western Development Museum between highway 16 and 40. The campground has 41 full-service sites and 20 non-serviced sites. Many of the sites are "pull-through" sites that can accommodate large trailers and RVs. Amenities include 2 showers/washroom facilities, a trailer disposal dump, playground, outdoor barbeques, firewood access and a trout pond.
