Curbside Garbage and Recycling Services

Placing Your Cart

1. Place it: Place the cart on the street with the wheels against the curb prior to 7:00 am on collection day. Allow approximately four feet clearance on both sides of the cart (ie: if there's vehicles parked behind usual cart placement).
2. Point it: Point the arrows on the cart lid toward the street.
3. Return it: place the cart back on your property by 7:00 pm on collection day.

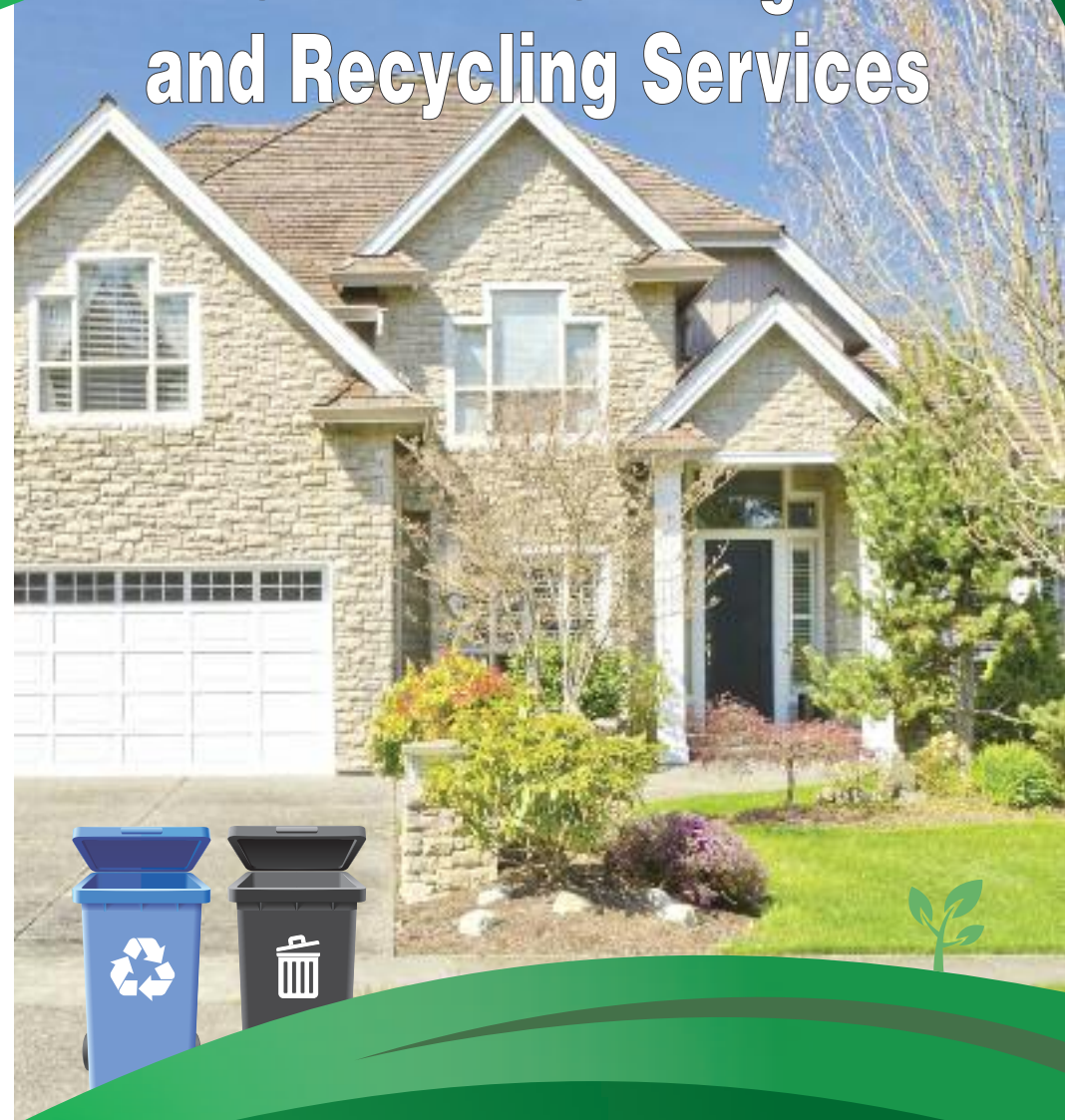

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle!

You have received one charcoal coloured roll out garbage cart (360 litres) and one blue roll out recycling cart (360 litres). It's all in an effort to encourage recycling, reduce the amount of waste in the City landfill, and eliminate ongoing abuse of the communal dumpsters. The new service benefits you, the environment, and the City.

Garbage

- The cart will hold approximately 3 large garbage bags (113 litre/30 gallon bags).
- Bag and place all regular and non-recyclable household garbage inside this cart.
- Cart lids must be completely closed. Carts with open lids will not be picked up.
- Material beside or on top of the carts will not be picked up.
- Not permitted: yard/garden waste, propane cylinders, tires, rocks, heavy materials, automotive batteries, corrosives, pesticides, herbicides, gas, solvents, thinners, oil, pharmaceuticals, hot ashes, hot materials, aerosol cans, construction material, carcasses, appliances, electronics, furniture.

Recycling

- Do not bag your recycling. Sorting is not necessary.
- Place only acceptable recyclable materials inside this cart (see diagram below).
- Do not place household garbage in this cart.
- Contents are transported by Loraas Environmental Services Ltd. to Saskatoon for recycling.



Glass

- Glass is not permitted in the recycling carts. Place it in the garbage or transport it to the glass depot at the Waste Management Facility (WMF), located east of Territorial Drive on Wearing Road. Hours are posted in the Garbage section at www.cityofnb.ca
- There is NO CHARGE at the WMF for glass. Glass is broken down and utilized as landfill cover.
- Contact Public Works (306-445-1730) about disposal of fluorescent light bulbs.

Compost

- Yard waste and compostable materials must be transported to the WMF.
- There is NO CHARGE at the WMF for yard waste (grass clippings, leaves) and compostable material.
- Trees and branches are not compostable materials.

Cart Collection

- Bi-weekly pickup (garbage one week, recycling the next). There will be a charge for more frequent pickups or, if hauling yourself, regular WMF fees apply. Proof of residency required at WMF for discount.
- On your collection day, ensure your cart is out by 7:00 am. Do not put the cart out sooner than the night before and place it back on your property by 7:00 pm on collection day.
- Store carts in a safe place on your property (ie: garage, carport, beside your house, inside your fence). Carts cannot be stored on the boulevard or on your front lawn.
