Frequently Asked Questions

What is a discretionary use? Discretionary uses are types of uses on a property that must be approved by Council after public notice is conducted.

What happens at the council meeting? At the council meeting the application will be presented to Council. If you have submitted a letter or an email regarding the application, it will be provided as public information.

Has the application been approved? The application has not been approved. The application for the discretionary use is being brought forward to council for consideration. At the June 27th, 2022 council meeting, council can approve the application, deny the application, or ask for more information.

Is this a City of North Battleford project? This is not a City of North Battleford project. Administration has received an application from an applicant looking to establish a Major Telecommunications Tower.

How can I voice my concerns or support? If you wish to provide comments on the application, you can submit your comments in writing in person at City Hall, through regular mail, or by email (corporateservices@cityofnb.ca). The deadline to submit comments is June 20th, 2022.

What is a Major Telecommunications Tower? A Major Telecommunications Tower is a telecommunication tower with a height measuring 15 metres or more.

How can I attend the Council Meeting? Council meetings are being conducted online through ZOOM. Access to the link can be found on the City's website www.cityofnb.ca or contact City Hall (306) 445-1700.
